CHAPTER - 1

## INTRODUCTION

#### 1. Brief History

#### 1.a Background

As provided by the Government of India Act 1919, the Lee Commission was constituted in 1923 under the Chairmanship of Lord Lee for the purpose of formulating principles / terms and conditions of Public Service and submitted its report in 1924 A.D. This led to the establishment of the first Public Service Commission on October, 1926 under the Chairmanship of Sir Ross Barker. The limited advisory function accorded to the Public Service Commission and the continued stress on this aspect by the leaders of our freedom movement resulted in the setting up of a Federal Public Service Commission and also Public Service Commission at the Provincial level under the Govt. of India Act, 1935. After Independence, the Constituent Assembly visualized the need for giving a secure and autonomous status to Public Service Commission, both at the Central and at the State level, for ensuring free and fair recruitment for the Public Service as well as for protecting the rights of Civil Servants, thus Public Service Commission was given a Constitutional status by promulgation of Constitution of India on 26 January, 1950.

Under Part XIV, Chapter I and in Articles 308 to 314 of the Constitution of India, the matter related to services under the Union and the States such as recruitment and conditions of service or person serving, tenure of office of persons serving, dismissal, removal or reduction in rank of persons employed have been provided.

Under Chapter II, subject to the provisions of the Article- 315, there shall be a Public Service Commission for the Union and a Public Service Commission for each state.

#### 1.b Tripura Public Service Commission

Before attaining Statehood on 21st January, 1972, Tripura was under jurisdiction of the Union Public Service Commission. After attaining Statehood, 'Tripura Public Service Commission' was established on 30th October, 1972 as per the provisions of Article 315 of the Constitution of India. Sri G. P. Bagchi was the 1st Chairman and Sri I.K. Roy was the 1st Member of the Tripura Public Service Commission.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 318, the Tripura Public Service Commission Regulations were framed by the Governor of Tripura in 1972 and as per said Regulations, the Commission shall consist of a Chairman and one or more Members not exceeding 3 (three) as may be determined by the Governor from time to time. The Chairman and Members so appointed are assisted by a Secretariat headed by the Secretary.

Tripura Public Service Commission is also regulated by the Tripura Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1973 framed by the Governor of Tripura as per provision of clause (3) (e) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India in respect of its functional activities.

#### 1.c Function of the State Public Service Commission

As per provisions of the Article 320 of the Constitution, the function of the State Public Service Commission shall be:-

- 1. Recruitment for Civil Services and Civil posts as per provisions of the Tripura Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulation, 1973 framed by the Governor of Tripura by:
  - i. By Direct Interview;
  - ii. Examination (Scheduled) followed by Personality Test / Viva- Voce;
  - iii. Screening Test (Non- Scheduled) followed by Interview;
  - iv. The Tripura Combined Competitive Examination for Recruitment to miscellaneous posts;
  - v. Conduct of Departmental Examination / Pre-Promotional Examination;
  - vi. Conduct of U.P.S.C. Examination at Agartala Centre.

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- 2. The State Public Service Commission shall be consulted:
  - i. On all matters relating to methods of recruitment of Civil Service and for civil posts of the State Government;
  - ii. On the principles to be followed in making appointments to Civil Services and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another and on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions on transfers;
  - iii. On all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under the Government of the State in a civil capacity, including memorials on petitions relating to such matters;
  - iv. On any claim by or in respect of a person who is serving or has served under the Government of the State in a civil capacity, that any costs incurred by him in defending legal proceedings instituted against him in respect of acts done or purporting to be done in the execution of his duty should be paid out of the consolidated fund of India, or as the case may be, out of the Consolidated Fund of the State;
  - v. On any claim for award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the Govt. of India or the Government of a State, in a civil capacity, and any question as to the amount of any such award.
- 3. And it shall be the duty of Public Service Commission to advice on any matter so referred to them and on any other matter which the President, or as the case may be, the Governor of the State, may refer to them.

Provided that the Governor, in respect of other services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State may make regulations specifying the matters in which either generally, or in any particular class of case or in any particular circumstances, it shall not be necessary for a Public Service Commission to be consulted.

#### 1.d Expenses

Under Article 322, the expenses of the State Public Service Commission, including any salaries, allowances and pensions payable to or in respect of the members of the Commission, shall be charged on the Consolidated Fund of India or as the case may be, the Consolidated Fund of the State.

#### 1.e Reports of the Public Service Commission

It shall be the duty of the Commission to present annually to the Hon'ble Governor of Tripura, a report as to the work done by the Commission and on receipt of such report, the Governor shall cause a copy thereof together with a Memorandum explaining, in respect of the cases, if any, where the advice of the Commission was not accepted, the reasons for such non-acceptance to be laid before each House of Parliament / State Legislative Assembly.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### 1. Total Requisitions Processed by the Commission:-

The Commission received 06 requisitions for recruitment of 51 posts from various Government Departments during the year under report. Taking into account of 08 carried over requisitions for 423 posts and 1 requisition in pursuance of judgment and Order dated 05-08-2019 arising upon WP(C) No. 186 of 2019 of Hon'ble High Court of Tripura , the Commission dealt with in total 15 requisitions for 475 (51 + 423+01) posts.

#### 2. Summary of Total requisitions:-

- a) Recommendation through Examination and Interview/Viva-voce:-The Commission recommended 46 (SC-07, ST-15 and UR-24) candidates through Examination and Interview/Viva-voce.
- **b)** Recommendation through Examination and Skill Test:- The Commission recommended 146 (SC-21, ST-32 and UR-93) candidates through Examination and Skill Test.
- c) Requisition Carry forwarded to next year:- The Commission could not complete the 07 requisitions in the year under report and carry forwarded to the next year.
- d) **Requisition cancelled:-** Recruitment to 02 requisitions were cancelled by the Commission during the year under report.

#### 3. Departmental Examinations / Pre- Promotional Examinations:-

During the year under report, the Tripura Public Service Commission dealt with 07 Departmental Examinations. Out of 07 Examinations, 05 were completed during the year, 01 was postponed until further notice and remaining 01 carry forwarded to next year 2020-21.

#### 4. Conduct of UPSC Examination at Agartala Centre:-

The Commission dealt with 08 UPSC Examinations during the year under report.

#### 5. Total Applications Received and Processed by the Commission:-

During the period under report, in total 13,691 applications were received by the Commission for Direct Recruitment. Brief descriptions of the recruitment process are given in Chapter-4. 644 candidates appeared before the Interview Board/Examination alongwith Skill Test and finally 192 candidates were recommended for appointment to various posts.

#### 6. Promotion and Recommendations:-

The Commission received 10 proposals for promotion to next higher posts from different departments, Government of Tripura. In total 205 (UR-53, ST-94, SC-54, ESM-04) individual cases were referred to the Commission for promotion. The Commission considered their service records etc. and finally recommended 46 (UR-25, SC-14, ST-07) officers/ staff for promotion to the various posts.

#### 7. Departmental Promotion Committee Meeting:-

During the year under report, the Commission received 08 proposals from different departments, Government of Tripura, involving 72 (UR-33, ST-22, SC-17) posts for selection of officers for promotion / confirmation. The Commission recommended 35 (UR-21, ST-03, SC-11) officers for promotion to the various posts.

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#### 8. Concurrence of Draft for Amendment of Recruitment Rules / Service Rules:-

The Commission received 21 proposals regarding concurrence of Draft Recruitment Rules / Service Rules from the different departments, Government of Tripura and 19 proposals were concurred by the Commission during the year under report and remaining 02 carry forwarded to next year 2020-21.

#### 9. **Disciplinary Proceedings cases:-**

The Commission received 09 proposals in connection with Disciplinary Proceedings cases from the different departments, Government of Tripura. The Commission has agreed with the proposals of the concerned departments and penalty was advised against all cases.

#### 10. **Representation of Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes:-**

Recruitment process by Competitive Selection through the method of Interview / Examination (Scheduled/ Non-Scheduled Examinations)/ Skill Test was completed for the 115 posts reserved for Scheduled Tribes and 49 posts reserved for Scheduled Castes during the year under report.

#### Implementation of provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005:-11.

The Tripura Public Service Commission received 225 requests under the RTI Act. The Commission responded to 193 requests during the year 2019-2020. The remaining 32 applications carry forwarded to next year 2020-21.

### CHAPTER - 5

### **REPRESENTATION OF ST AND SC CANDIDATES**

During the year under report, Commission dealt with 165 [ 49 (SC) and 116(ST) ] posts reserved for Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes. 15 ST candidates and 7 SC candidates were recommended through Examination followed by Interview/Viva-voce only. Further, 32 ST candidates and 21 SC candidates were recommended through Examination alongwith Skill Test.

So, total number of candidates recommended against ST and SC vacancy are as follows:-

It may be mentioned here that, 11 SC candidates and 1 ST candidate were also recommended against UR vacancy during the year under report.

### PROBLEMS OF RURAL CANDIDATES AND THE COMMISSION'S VIEW ABOUT THE REMEDIES

Regarding the problem of rural candidates and its remedial measures etc. the Commission had pointed out in its earlier reports and this year also, the position remained unchanged. During the year under report, the Commission reiterated its earlier view regarding the poor performance of the candidates who were coming from rural areas. Generally speaking, their performance was not as good as those who were coming from urban areas in Interviews/Personality Test.

#### 1. Reason for Relatively Poor Performance of Rural Candidates:-

The Commission is of the opinion that the reason for relatively poor performance of rural candidates in Interview/Personality Test are as follows:-

- (i) Non availability of reference books, Library facilities, Newspapers, Journals (particularly all India Newspapers) in rural areas specially in remote villages.
- (ii) Lack of opportunities to associate themselves with Institutions /Organizations which help in the development of art of expression of ideas/thoughts in an articulate and cogent manner. It is also observed by the Commission that information regarding advertisement does not reach to the candidates in rural areas in time even though such advertisements are published in several local dailies and also broadcast/telecast through All India Radio and Doordarshan and uploaded in the website of the TPSC. The Commission also noticed that sufficient number of qualified candidates are not available for reserved vacancies particularly, those requiring technical qualifications.

#### 2. The Commission's Suggestions:-

The Commission suggested that the following steps may be taken by the Government to thwart the problems of candidates coming from rural areas, especially remote villages.

- (a) Government may publish monthly News Bulletin covering information about employment opportunities, under the State as well as Central Government which may be widely circulated through Block and Panchayat Agencies. The posts advertised by the T.P.S.C., U.P.S.C., and Staff Selection Commission, etc. may also be published through the News Bulletin.
- (b) Coaching facilities may be provided not only at District level but also at the Panchayat level to up-grade the standard of knowledge of rural candidates. The candidates should be aware of the employment opportunities and competitive examinations held by the different Agencies. Syllabus of important Competitive Examinations and specimen questions and model answers may be published and distributed by the Government in rural areas at nominal cost.
- (c) Steps may be taken to strengthen the Panchayat Libraries. Books and periodicals related to competitive examinations may be available with these libraries.
- (d) SC/ST students ,particularly, who are from remote villages may be encouraged to take up Technical/ Professional Courses of education so that adequate number of such candidates become available for filling up of the reserved posts in course of time. Government Departments sponsoring candidates for technical education/training may ensure that adequate numbers of ST/SC candidates are sponsored for such courses so that there is no shortage of ST/SC candidates for appointment to Technical posts.
- (e) The Commission reiterates the problems stated above in its earlier reports. Therefore, the Government may take special endeavor to take positive steps to implement the advice/suggestions of the Commission.

CHAPTER-7

### RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005 AND ITS IMPLEMENTATION

Right to Information Act, 2005 mandates timely response to citizen making requests for Government information. During the year under report, the Tripura Public Service Commission received 225 requests under the RTI Act. The Commission responded to 193 requests during the year under report. Remaining 32 requests were disposed off after 31.03.2020.

### NEW INITIATIVE BY THE COMMISSION IN THE PRESENT YEAR (1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL, 2019 TO 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 2020)

Key initiatives by the Tripura Public Service Commission during last one year for improving efficiency, transparency and Fast tracking the Examination Process are:-

## 1. INTRODUCTION OF ONLINE SYSTEM FOR FILLING UP OF APPLICATION AND E- ADMIT CARD GENERATING SYSTEM IN VARIOUS EXAMINATIONS:

TPSC has introduced Online System for filling up of applications in all examinations conducted by the TPSC and also the auto generating system of e- admit card. The system facilitates submission of applications by the candidates from their locations and it generates e- admit card which helps the candidate to track their Exam. centre, date and time of the Examination etc. well in advance. Earlier, the candidates had to collect application forms from Banks and deposit fee in the Banks which caused lot of inconvenience in applying to the TPSC exams. With online system of filling the application forms, the processing time has reduced considerably and it has increased accuracy of data. Further, the admit cards used to be generated manually and sent to candidates through posts which caused delay. But now all admit cards are generated online and candidate can download it sitting at his home.

## 2. RATIONALIZATION OF THE SYLLABUS FOR SELECTION PROCESS OF TCS GRADE – II AND TPS GRADE – II:

TPSC has simplified the procedure for selection of candidates to the post of Tripura Civil Service and Tripura Police Service Grade-II. The revised syllabus consists of 08 compulsory papers only against existing 56 papers with optional subjects. This has resulted in level playing field to all the candidates irrespective of their subject. Further, it has reduced the time taken in setting question papers as well as reduced the time in evaluation of answer scripts.

#### 3. INTRODUCTION OF CCTV IN COMMISSION'S PREMISES:-

The Commission has upgraded its own Examination Hall by installation of CCTV for secured, transparent and maintaining proper Examination system to be monitored centrally. Further, the CCTV has also been installed at key locations in the building for 24 hours monitoring and maintaining security.

#### 4. CENTRALIZED EVALUATION SYSTEM:-

The Commission has introduced Centralized Evaluation System for speedy completion of Recruitment process with utmost security in TPSC building itself. Earlier the answer scripts used to be sent to the Examiners at their place for evaluation, who used to take their own time in evaluation and also there was risk of its loss and maintaining confidentiality. Now the evaluation is done in-house in TPSC building with utmost security and confidentiality and in a time bound manner. This has increased the credibility of the system and considerably reduced the time for completing the examination process within a year.

#### 5. UPGRADATION OF THE WEBSITE OF THE COMMISSION:

The website of the Tripura Public Service Commission is being upgraded from static mode to dynamic mode which would make the website more user friendly and user oriented. The work is under process and likely to be completed soon.

#### 6. INTRODUCTION OF NEW EXAMINATION CENTRE AT AMBASSA AND DHARMANAGAR:

In order to cater to the needs of candidates from remote locations, a new examination centre at Ambasa, Dhalai District was opened in 2019. Another new examination centre at Dharmanagar will be introduced from next major examination.
