NOTIFICATION

It is hereby notified that the next Departmental Examination for IAS & TCS, Grade-II and IPS & TPS, Grade-II Officers under the Government of Tripura as per TCS (Training and Departmental Examination) Rules 1975 and the TPS (Departmental Examination) Rules, 1981 will be conducted by the Tripura Public Service Commission and will commence on and from **1st June, 2021**. All the Officers intending to appear at the said Examination are requested to submit application through Online Application Portal with an Application Fee of Rs.250/- **on or before 12th March, 2021**. Online Application Portal will be available on Commission's website from **19.02.2021 to 12.03.2021 (5.30 PM)**. After the closing date of submission of online application, the Commission will refer entire list of candidates to GA(P&T) Department, Govt. of Tripura for vetting of the Department towards permission to sit in the said Departmental Examination. The Commission will allow to sit the candidates in the examination only after receiving permission from the GA(P&T) Department.

Application received after the closing date will not be entertained in any case. The list of eligible candidates, Programme of the Examination & Admission Certificate(s) of eligible candidates will be uploaded in the Commission's website (<http://www.tpsc.tripura.gov.in>) in due time.

Online Application:

(a) Applicants will have to submit application through Online Application Portal only. The Commission will not entertain any hard copy application. Before submission of online application, read carefully the instruction to candidates.


(b) Online Application Portal will be available on Commission's website from **19.02.2021 to 12.03.2021 (5.30 PM)**. Before applying an applicant shall register his/her bio- data particulars through One Time Profile Registration (OTPR) on the Commission's Website viz <http://www.tpsc.tripura.gov.in>. Once applicant registers his/her particulars, a User ID is generated and sent to his/her registered mobile number and email ID. Applicants need to apply using the OTPR User ID through the Commission's website.

(c) Applicants should avoid submitting multiple applications. However, if due to any unavoidable circumstances, any applicant submits multiple applications then he/she must ensure that the application with latest Receipt Number is complete in all respects.

(d) In case of multiple applications, the application with latest Receipt Number shall only be entertained by the Commission and fee paid against one Receive Number shall not be adjusted against any other Receipt Number.

(e) Examination fee so deposited, is non refundable. Unpaid application is summarily rejected.
