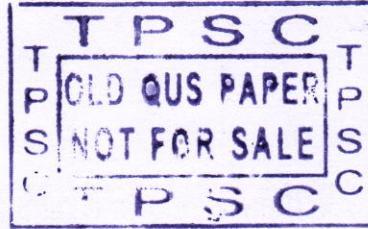

- This Test Booklet is divided into two parts i.e. Part-I, and Part-II.
  - Part-I (MCQ pattern)** contains 50 items (questions). Each question, carrying one (1) mark only, has four responses (answers). You will select the response which you want to mark on the **OMR Sheet**. In case you feel that there is more than one correct response, mark the response which you consider the most appropriate. In any case choose **ONLY ONE** response for each item.
  - Questions under **Part-II (Conventional Method)** contain 50 marks is to be answered in separate **Answer Book**. Answers to the questions of Part-II must be written either in English or in Bengali. It must not be answered partly in English and partly in Bengali. This instruction should be followed scrupulously.
- You have to mark all your responses of **Part-I** by **Black Ball Point pen only** on the separate OMR Answer Sheet provided. See directions in the Answer Sheet.
- Before you proceed to answer the responses to various items in the Test Booklet, you have to fill in some particulars both in the OMR Answer Sheet for Part-I and in the Answer Book for Part-II.
- On completion of the Examination, you must handover the OMR Answer Sheet for Part-I and Answer Book for Part -II to the Invigilator only. You are permitted to take the Test Booklet with you.
- Sheets for rough work are appended on the Test Booklet at the end.
- Penalty for wrong answers for Part-I only :**
  - There will be four alternatives for the answer to every question. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, **one fourth** of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.
  - If a candidate gives more than one answer, it will be treated as a **Wrong Answer** even if one of the given answers happens to be correct and there will be same penalty as above to that question.
  - If a question is left blank i.e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be **no penalty** for that question.

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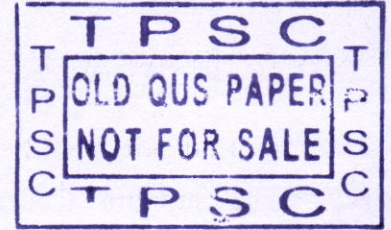
Four options are given against each of the following questions. Select the best/correct option from among the four options and encode in the Answer Sheet by using **Black Ball Point Pen** only as per example given below :
